Group Home Akari

Group Home Akari is an ordinary large house located in a quiet residential area in the Setagaya ward. People with symptoms of dementia live together while helping and supporting each other. Daily walks to nearby parks and temples are part of our residents' daily routine. We go shopping at a local supermarket, which is about a 30 minute walk away. We also cook meals together. They cut vegetables quickly with their old skills. Life at Akari is as normal as life before dementia. We always remember to laugh and cherish our interactions with each other. Many residents have memory impairment, but we are always cheering them on. In turn, we receive many words of gratitude from them. Akari lives with the importance of "living in the present together".

We are a community-based group home located in a completely residential area of Setagaya and Chitosedai. Through exercises of rehabilitation and recreation, we make the progress of dementia gentle and allow for healthy living. Experienced staff continue to provide high-quality services with our 'hearts' and carefully keep in touch with residents and their families so that both can "live in the same time together".

Short-term use of Group Home (short stay):

Akari Group Home accepts short stays covered by long-term care insurance. Short-term stays are available only when a current resident is hospitalized for a long period of time and has vacated his/her room; in which

"Shared Day" Akari:

Shared Day Service is a day service provided using the shared space of our group home. Unlike regular day care services, this service allows residents to spend a day together with the group home residents in a relaxed atmosphere.

Day Service Center Honoka Chitosedai:

Day Service Center Honoka Chitosedai is a day service built in Chitosedai, Setagaya Ward. People with dementia attend the center, which has a group home adjacent to it. The small number of residents (12) makes it a very "homey" day service. Every day Honoka goes shopping to a nearby supermarket and prepares meals. Users take the lead in preparing lunch together with the staff, and we also try to create an atmosphere where they can enjoy their meals. We encourage interaction among users and prevent the decline of physical functions by having them take on roles they are good at. There is a park nearby, so we actively provide many opportunities for outings. We are open Monday through Saturday and on holidays. We also offer transfers or additional use for family members' urgent business or convenience.

Additionally, we provide individual functional training by an occupational therapist; we can help prevent muscle weakness in the lower limbs and help those live at home until the end of their lives. (Wednesdays only)

Greetings:

The Setagaya Chitosedai Office provides day care services for those with dementia (Day Service Center Honoka Chitosedai) and communal living care services for people with dementia (Group Home Akari). Our staff members have a deep understanding of our clients and by treating them with respect and kindness, they are able to build a family-like relationship with clients, who in turn greet them with kindness and smiles. Our job is to make them smile and live as one of our family members even if dementia makes it difficult for them to live alone. We will strive to provide even better quality services while receiving energy from our clients and growing as individual staff members.

Short Stay Shiawase-no-Hi

Short-stay services are available for those who need to leave his or her house unanticipatedly (emergency entry). "Shiawase no Hi" is the first single-unit type short-term care facility in Toshima ward that provides overnight care services to elderly people who have been certified (with Certification of Needed Support/Long-term care) for nursing care. The facility is equipped with bathing facilities that can be used even by bedridden residents and all rooms are private rooms, so one can enjoy a relaxing stay as if his or her were in a hotel. It is only a 2-minute walk from "Zoushigaya" Station on the Fukutoshin Line and there are parks and shrines in the neighborhood, making it a comfortable environment. We look forward to serving you.

Located in a residential area of Minami-Ikebukuro, it is in a very convenient location for family visits. We offer beautiful private rooms with a capacity of 24 people. Our staff are young, enthusiastic, and experienced; their positivity bring days of constant laughter and happiness, as well as services accommodated to each resident. We welcome short-term use, long-term use, emergency entry, and various medical practices at our facility.

Home-Visit Nursing Station Sato:

We support those who "want to stay at home as much as possible even if they are sick or disabled. Home-Visit Nursing Care is a service in which nurses visit families (based on the instructions of the attending physician) to provide nursing and rehabilitation services according to the symptoms of the patient, based on the instructions of the patient's doctor.

We tend to those who:

- Have a disease or anxiety in daily life
- · Have worries about muscle weakness or falling
- · Need medical treatment such as intravenous drips and bedsores
- · Do not know how to take care of someone with dementia or someone who needs end-of-life care

We support the patient's and their family's wish to "live as one's self in one's own home, in one's own familiar place, despite illness or disability". We strive to be a bridge between medical care, nursing care, and welfare by promptly cooperating with doctors, care managers, welfare offices, etc., so that patients and their families can live comfortably and safely. Certified home health care nurses are on staff, so please be assured you are in good hands.

In the event of an emergency, we have a system to provide at-home care 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Please consult with your primary physician and your care manager.

Home-visit Nursing Care Hoho-emi Care Service:

Home-visit nursing care is a service in which a qualified helper from a home-visit nursing care agency visits a patient's home to provide assistance in daily living, including: physical care (dressing, bathing, toileting, eating, etc) and daily living assistance (shopping for daily necessities, meal preparation, cleaning, laundry, receiving medicine, etc). This service is indispensable for in-home care when you want to take care of your loved one at home as much as possible, but you do not have enough time or hands to do so. Please consult with the care manager.

Greeting:

The Toshima Office is a 2-minute walk from Zoshigaya Station on the Tokyo Metro Fukutoshin Line, in the heart of the city, yet in a peaceful location with Minami Ikebukuro Park and Kishimojin nearby. We provide three services: short stay (Shiawase-no-hi, home nursing (Sato), and in-home care (Hoho-emi). By utilizing the strength of the same office and smoothly sharing information and cooperating with one another, we are able to provide continuous and seamless services where users can continue to live in their familiar areas. We aim to provide high quality services by collaborating with various professionals in the community so that each service can help each user to live their life in their own way.

We make daily efforts to tend to the wishes of each and every patient. All rooms have tatami mats, so one can feel the warmth of the wood. Air-conditioning and heating are provided for each room as well. There is floor heating available in the living room and hallway. You can stay warm even in the coldest winter. We provide an enjoyable place to live and thus residents have constant smiles on their faces. We support individual outings, annual events, and music therapy.

We strive to create a warm in-home atmosphere. Please come and visit us! Day Service Honoka Higashi Yaguchi is a small-scale day service for people with dementia (12 person capacity). We provide support so that those with dementia can come to the center and maintain their social skills and daily life functions, as well as enjoy their days. Our main programs are cooking lunch and going on outings. We plan the menu for each day's lunch with the residents and go shopping at a nearby supermarket. We are able to provide hot meals that everyone wants to eat and/or we take meal requests. Lunch together with everyone becomes an enjoyable atmosphere with lively conversation. When the cherry blossom viewing season comes around, we of course go out to view the plum and cherry blossoms, and when residents say, "I want to eat out today," or "I want to go outside for a while," we incorporate this into our programs so that they can go out to eat or go on outings.

Greeting:

The Ota Office provides day care services for people with dementia (Day Service Center Honoka Higashi Yaguchi) and communal living care services for people with dementia (Group Home Sakura-no-Ie Higashi Yaguchi). Child Development Support Center "Sakura no Michi"

We provide activities to develop each child's potential through play.

Child Development Support Sakura no Michi" is a rehabilitation facility for preschool children with developmental concerns. This is the first business for children in Outoukai and was newly opened in Ikegami, Ota-ku, Tokyo. We provide solid care using the knowledge and techniques we have learned from nursing care. In addition to care, we will provide activities to develop each child's potential through play and production, such as physical exercise in a bright and open room, sitting down and using their hands and fingers. Using "Eurythmic and Montessori Education," we will develop knowledge and basic movements for these children. We also use "sensory exercises" to develop each child's body to adapt to group life. We praise "what the child has accomplished" and provide "enjoyable time" for the child's rehabilitation.

For Families:

We provide rehabilitation education in spacious, clean classrooms that are carefully designed for safety. We also have a clean consultation room where privacy is protected and families can consult with us about any concerns they may have. During the treatment and education, you can take a break while watching your child nearby. The location is close to Ikegami Station and the "Chidori 2-chome" bus stop, so shopping is also readily available nearby.

Greeting:

Sakura-no-michi is located in a picturesque area near Honnoji Temple and Tokumochi Shrine.

At Sakura-no-michi, we provide medical care and education tailored to the development of each child, incorporating the five areas necessary for child development support: (1) health and lifestyle, (2) movement and sensory, (3) cognition and behavior, (4) language and communication, and (5) human relations and social skills. Children grow through a variety of experiences and learning, so we hope to help them do so by enhancing the content of our rehabilitation programs.
